

**LEGAL NOTICE
CITY OF HERMITAGE
ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

The City of Hermitage will receive sealed bids for the “2018 Capital Paving Program”, which consists of the milling and HMA paving of approximately 9,745 SY of roadway, until 1:30 PM, local time on April 4, 2018 for the furnishing of all labor and materials required for the performance of the specified work. Bids will be received at the Office of the City Manager, Hermitage Municipal Building, 800 North Hermitage Road, Hermitage, PA 16148.

Proposals shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to Gary P. Hinkson, City Manager and shall bear the words “2018 Capital Paving Program”. Sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately following the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids. Bids received after the above stated time will be returned unopened. Faxed bids will not be accepted.

All asphalt paving on this project shall be performed by a prime contractor or subcontractor that is prequalified with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

Bidding Documents, including Project Specifications, Locations Maps and Bid Forms, are available for examination, and may be obtained at the City of Hermitage Municipal Building, 800 North Hermitage Road, Hermitage, PA 16148 after March 14, 2018 at a non-refundable cost of \$50.

A Non Mandatory General Bidders Meeting will be held at the City Building, 800 N. Hermitage Road, Hermitage, Pennsylvania 16148, on March 28, 2018 at 1:30 PM.

Bids must be submitted on the forms supplied in the Contract Documents. Only plan holders of record are eligible to bid. Each bid must be accompanied by a Certified Check, Cashier’s Check, or Bid Bond in the amount of 10% of the bid made payable to the City of Hermitage. The successful bidder will be required to submit a 100% Performance Bond and Payment Bond.

Bidders must submit with their bids the non-collusion affidavit contained in the contract documents. Prevailing wages established under the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act will apply to this contract.

The City of Hermitage Bid Advertisement and Procurement efforts provide for open and free competition among available bidders and the City takes affirmative steps to assure that small, minority and women business enterprises are utilized when possible. If any subcontracts are to be let by the successful bidder, as part of the project, the prime contractor must take the necessary affirmative steps to assure that small, minority and women business enterprises are utilized when possible.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities, and to award contracts in its best interest. No bid may be withdrawn after bid opening for a period of sixty (60) days thereafter.
