Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Bond in the amount of not less than 10% of the total bid. A 100% Performance & Payment Bond is required for this work.

All bids shall be irrevocable for 60 days after the bid opening date unless award is delayed by a required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds, or award of the grant or grants, in which case this Bid shall remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the bid opening date provided the Act of November 26, 1978 (P.L. 1309, No. 317), as amended by the Act of December 12, 1994 (P.L. 1042, No. 142). Bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

The City reserves the right to waive any defects, errors, omissions, mistakes, informalities, to accept any bid or combination of bids that are deemed to be in the best interest of the City, and to reject any or all proposals.

Prevailing wages established under the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this contract. The Contract Documents contain requirements addressing prevailing labor wage rates, labor standards, non discrimination in hiring practices, goals for MBE/WBE participation, participation by Section 3 residents and businesses, Steel Product Procurement Act and related matters.

Attention is called to the fact that the project is funded by a City of Hermitage Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program administered by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development. The Contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, regulations, and program guidelines.
