The bid specifications, drawings, plan holders list, addenda, and other bid information shall be available for viewing at the City of Hermitage Municipal Building during normal business working hours.

Bids must be in accordance with drawings and specifications and on forms available from the City of Hermitage at a non-refundable cost of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) mailed. Documents may be ordered by calling (724) 977-1775 or email igarfoli@iagconsultinginc.com.

There will be a **Pre-bid Conference on July 15, 2022 at 11:00 AM** at the Hermitage Municipal Building, 800 North Hermitage Road, Hermitage, PA 16148.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Bond in the amount of not less than 10% of the total bid. A 100% Performance & Payment Bond is required for this work.

All bids shall be irrevocable for 60 days after the bid opening date unless award is delayed by a required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds, or award of the grant or grants, in which case this Bid shall remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the bid opening date provided the Act of November 26, 1978 (P.L. 1309, No. 317), as amended by the Act of December 12, 1994 (P.L. 1042, No. 142). Bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

The City reserves the right to waive any defects, errors, omissions, mistakes, informalities, to accept any bid or combination of bids that are deemed to be in the best interest of the City, and to reject any or all proposals.

Contract Documents contain requirements addressing prevailing labor wage rates, labor standards, and Steel Product Procurement Act and related matters.

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

The project is being funded by ARPA Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) and bidders are required to comply with all applicable federal statutes, regulations and executive orders including the Department of Treasury Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Interim Final Rule (to the extent a provision of the Interim Final Rule remains in effect), the Department of Treasury Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Final Rule, and the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (Code of Federal Regulations "Uniform Guidance" or 2 CFR Part 200).

In accordance with the US Department of Treasury Final Rule, the City of Hermitage has elected to utilize the Standard Allowance for Revenue Loss which applies to all funds received by the City under the Act and intends to use all of its ARPA funds for the provision of Government Services.

In accordance with the US Treasury guidance the City requires project bidders to adhere to strong labor standards and pay workers at or above the Prevailing Wage Rates and strongly encourages the utilization of local hires.

It is the proposing Bidder's responsibility to read the entire bid package and addenda and comply with all ARPA funding requirements.
