Maintenance Technician in the Hermitage Water Pollution Control Department. Monitors control panels, adjusts valves, interprets meter readings, operates pumps, engines, and generators to regulate and control the flow of sewage; performs routine maintenance on sewage plant equipment; performs grass and landscape maintenance and general facility maintenance; maintains logs of operations; assists with cleaning lines and manholes; performs smoke testing; operates inspection equipment.
