City of Hermitage (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

**Monticello Avenue Stormwater & Roadway Improvements Project
00100-2509Re**

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the office of the City Manager, Hermitage Municipal Building located at 800 North Hermitage Road, Hermitage, PA 16148, until Wednesday, July 16, 2025 at 10:00 AM local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Installation of approximately 2,071 lineal feet of 12" diameter HDPE storm sewer; 14 precast concrete 2' x 2' catch basins; 3 precast concrete 2' x 4' catch basins; four 60-inch diameter stormwater manholes; connecting approximately 50 existing roof drains to the storm sewer (both existing and proposed); approximately 71 LF of concrete curb replacement; milling approximately 5,718 SY of roadway; 865 tons of binder course; 5,718 SY of wearing course asphalt; concrete and asphalt driveway adjustments; site restoration and other minor improvements and restoration items; demolition of existing facilities .

The Project has an expected duration of **60** days.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

For all further requirements regarding bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount of not less than 10% of the total bid. A 100% Performance and Payment Bond is required for this work.

All bids shall be irrevocable for 60 days after the bid opening date unless award is delayed by a required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds, or award of the grant or grants, in which case this Bid shall remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the bid opening date provided the Act of November 26, 1978 (P.L. 1309, No. 317), as amended by the Act of December 12, 1994 (P.L. 1042, No. 142). Bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

The City reserves the right to waive any defects, errors, omissions, mistakes, informalities, to accept any bid or combination of bids that are deemed to be in the best interest of the City, and to reject any or all proposals.

Contract Documents contain requirements addressing prevailing labor wage rates, labor standards, and Steel Product Procurement Act and related matters.
