There will be a Pre-bid Conference on July 12, 2022 at 11:00 AM at the Hermitage Municipal Building, 800 North Hermitage Road, Hermitage, Pennsylvania 16148.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Bond in the amount of not less than 10% of the total bid. A 100% Performance & Payment Bond is required for this work.

All bids shall be irrevocable for 60 days after the bid opening date unless award is delayed by a required approval of another government agency or the sale of bonds in which case this Bid shall remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the bid opening date provided the Act of November 26, 1978 (P.L. 1309, No. 317), as amended by the Act of December 12, 1994, (P.L. 1042, No. 142). Bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Attention is called to the fact that the project is funded by a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development. The Contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, regulations, and program guidelines. The grant contracts are made part of the Contract Documents.
