§ 12-101. Declaration of Support. [Res. 9-2007, 2/12/2007, § 1]

The City of Hermitage supports the Library's decision and plan to dissolve and supports the Community Library as a nonprofit corporation that will provide the resources of a community library promoting education, general welfare and improved quality of life to Hermitage residents.

§ 12-102. Release of Interests in Former Library. [Res. 9-2007, 2/12/2007, § 2]

The City of Hermitage does hereby release, remise and quit claim any right, title and interest, or claim of such, in and to the assets currently or formerly owned, possessed or controlled by the Shenango Valley Community Library whether by direct or indirect contribution of assets or funds for the support of the operation.

§ 12-103. Appointment of Directors. [Res. 9-2007, 2/12/2007, § 3]

The City of Hermitage, pursuant to the corporate bylaws, and being authorized thereunder, hereby agrees to appoint three residents of the City to be initial Directors representing the City on the Board of Directors of the Community Library of the Shenango Valley. § 12-104. Advisory Committee Representatives. [Res. 9-2007, 2/12/2007, § 4]
